On behalf of all of us here at Circle Tail, I would like to personally extend a thank you to you for your generous support of our assistance dog program.

In 2006, 9 full public access assistance dog teams, 3 in-home assistance dogs and 3 in-home companion dogs were partnered with people with disabilities. We also placed 3 facility dogs in retirement centers in the greater Cincinnati area. Our Assistance Dog Club, which is open to anyone with an assistance dog in our area, met 11 times for educational meetings and social outings. Circle Tail was also instrumental in changing Ohio law to allow public access rights for trainers of assistance dogs. All of this was accomplished due to the supportive donors and wonderful volunteers of Circle Tail.
